Fellowship Overview

About the Fellowship

1. Fellowships are 12 or 24 weeks in duration and will occur during the summer of 2007.
2. Selected Candidates will receive a stipend of \$7,500 dollars for each 12-week Fellowship, which will be paid out by the participating NGO, after applicable taxes are deducted. Longer Fellowships will be compensated proportionally.
3. Applicants may apply to more than one Fellowship. A separate application is required for each position.
4. Past MAP Fellows are ineligible.

Application Process

1. Complete and return this application to the address of the organization of your choice.
2. Attach your resume describing school, work, and volunteer experience.
3. Attach your most recent transcript(s), undergraduate and graduate (if applicable). An unofficial transcript (scanned or copied) is acceptable.
4. Attach two letters of recommendation to the address specified on the job description. Write applicant name and "SEF" in the subject line.
5. Include a short writing sample if requested by the organization to which you are applying.

Selection And Notification

1. Applications must be postmarked or emailed by January 26, 2007 for consideration.
2. Interviews of top candidates will occur by February 21, 2007.
3. Offers will be made by March 5, 2007 and accepted and finalized by March 6, 2007.
4. A reception for the first class of Sustainable Energy Fellows will be held in May 2007.
5. Most Fellowships will begin in June 2007.

Criteria For Applicants

1. Qualified students are enrolled graduate and undergraduate students at Stanford University (either currently enrolled or former students with no more than a 3-year time lapse since graduation) and at least 18 years of age.
2. The job focus will support efforts that address developing a more sustainable energy future, and or environmental problems and legacy of our past and present energy sources.
